The next few questions explore your legal rights and what medical treatments you can choose at the end of life should you lose the ability to make decisions for. Your ability to make decisions is called mental capacity - if you become unable to communicate for any reason with your healthcare team, e.g. you are in a coma, have been heavily sedated by your healthcare team or are in the late stages of dementia, you may no longer have mental capacity.

If you were dying with no prospect of recoveryin the last days and weeks of life, which ONE of the following would you prefer?

Comfort care only - this is when you are kept comfortable until you die. Nothing is done to prolong or extend your life, however measures are taken to ensure you are pain free and do not suffer. You would not be artificially tube fed or resuscitated.

Limited additional intervention – this includes all comfort care measures, plus some medication, such as artificial tube feeding or antibiotics, which may prolong life, but would not treat the underlying disease. You would not be resuscitated or put on a ventilator.

All available treatment - this includes comfort care and limited additional intervention, in addition you would receive all available treatments to prolong life such as artificial ventilation and resuscitation.
